

## MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE DNV Climate Change Services AS

Organisational responsibilities have been defined within DNV Climate Change Services as shown in below organisational chart.



The Managing Director manages the activities of DNV Climate Change Services AS and oversees that the operation of DNV Climate Change Services AS is executed professionally and efficiently.

The Director of Services and Technologies is responsible for all technical aspects of the activities related to DNV Climate Change Services AS' CDM accreditation by the UNFCCC. The Director of Services and Technologies approves contract reviews and team nominations for the validation and verification/certification of CDM project activities, oversees the allocation of Technical Reviewer and approves final CDM validation and verification/certification reports.

The Director of Operations manages DNV Climate Change Services AS' global operations of validation and verification services.

The Quality Manager's function is to develop, implement and maintain the Quality Management System for the validation and verification/certification of CDM project activities.

The Impartiality Committee is independent from all validation and verification/certification operations of DNV Climate Change Services AS and reports directly to the top management of DNV Climate Change Services AS. The Impartiality Committee reviews and approves the conflict of interest analysis and the mitigation measures described by DNV Climate Change Services AS.
